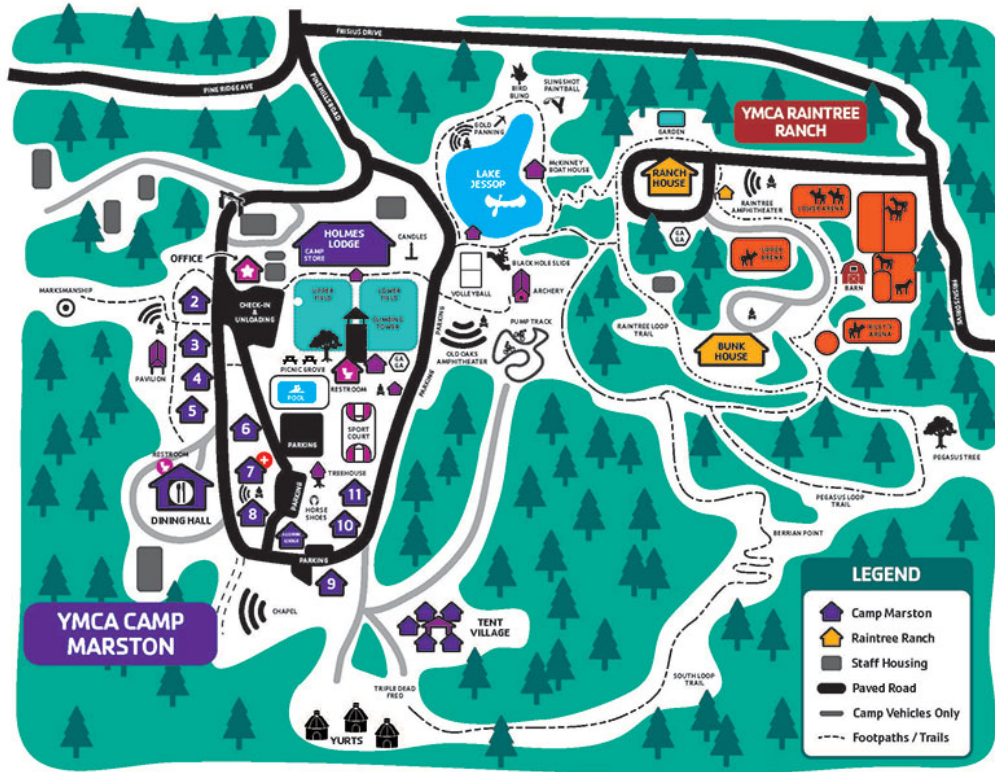
Guided Vs. Unguided Activities:

***What are "Camp Activities"?** : Camp Activities are program areas that must be led by YMCA staff. These activities include Archery, BBs, Black-hole Slide, Pumptrack, Slingshots, Candle making, Climbing Wall! Availability of these activities during the day depends on staffing, but all activities will be open at some point of the day.

Fires: Firewood is provided by Camp Marston. Please keep all fires in designated fire pits. These are located: by the lake, between lodges 2&3, between lodges 7&8, and at the gazebo by the climbing wall. When finished, please douse the fire pit thoroughly with water. All fire pits have a hose nearby except for between lodges 2&3. In this case, please use the buckets that live inside the broom closets. Any unattended fires will be extinguished.

BBQs: Grilling and BBQing is welcome on your own grills, and on any area that is not asphalt, cement, or decking.

Quiet Hours: We ask that quiet hours begin at 10pm and end at 7am.
