Leadership Training Programs Camp Marston, Camp Surf & Raintree Ranch

We offer Leadership Programs at all of our camps throughout the summer. These programs were designed by campers to meet their needs and goals. They all offer opportunities to work with our staff to take on a leadership role and mentor younger campers with an emphasis on camp activities, opportunities for new experiences, and spending time with peers.

The Camp Assistant (CA) program is an opportunity for campers who have completed the 2 week leadership programs (LIT or SOUL Surfers), or have demonstrated leadership through school, volunteer, or work experiences, to take on the challenges of leadership in camp. CA's make a 3 week commitment, and assist in a variety of camp program areas including sports, crafts, leading games, evening programs, aquatics, horses at Marston, Raintree Ranch or day camp at Camp Surf. They are also role models for younger campers.

The CA program is a competitive volunteer experience for those teens entering 12th grade and they must apply and interview for placement. They must be responsible, dependable, and self-motivated. They should have either completed our leadership program or demonstrate proof of similar training and experience. Although supervised by camp staff, CA's must be able to work successfully as individuals and as part of a group. There is no charge for the CA program.

Who should apply?

The CA program is designed to build skills and provide leadership opportunities for teens. However, we are looking for participants who want to be at camp, are responsible, energetic, positive, and motivated. They must be a good role model and capable of working with diverse children in a positive and supportive manner.

Applicants for the CA Program: DO NOT fill out a camp registration form.

Return this completed CA application and signed Code of Conduct to the camp where you would like to apply.

Camp Assistant Code of Conduct

1. CAs shall be a positive role model for youth by 12. Profanity, inappropriate jokes, sharing of intimate maintaining an attitude of caring, honesty, respect and details of one's personal life, and any kind of harassment responsiblity. is prohibited. 2. CAs shall use positive techniques of guidance, 13. CAs shall refrain from intimate displays of affection including redirection, positive reinforcement and towards others. Personal relationships beyond friendship encouragement rather than competition, comparison are not appropriate at camp. and criticism. 14. CAs must be supervised by a staff member at all times. 3. CAs should be aware of the health of children and tell the nurse, camp staff or program director if something 15. CAs are required to report observed violations of is noticed. the Code of Conduct to the Director, Unit Leader or Coordinator. 4. CAs shall respond to children with respect and consideration and treat all children equally regardless 16. CAs will not be able to leave camp other than with a of sex, sexuality, race, religion or culture. parent or legal quardian. 5. CAs shall appear clean, neat and appropriately attired. 17. At no time will CAs be with staff members during activities unrelated to camp or outside of camp unless it is an organized camp trip with appropriate staff supervision. 6. CAs shall respect all children's right to not be touched in ways that make them feel uncomfortable and their right to say no. 18. CAs are to remain on Camp for the duration of their stay at Camp Surf, Marston, or Raintree. 7. CAs shall not abuse children including: physical injury (strike, spank, slap); verbal abuse (humiliate, degrade, 19. CAs will not be permitted to drive, or have a vehicle at threaten); sexual abuse (inappropriate touch or verbal Camp without a note from parent/quardian on file with exchange); unjustifiable punishment (shaming, cruelty); **Program Director.** neglect (withholding food, water). 20. Auto keys must be handed in to Program Director upon arrival. They will be returned at departure time. 8. Any type of abuse will not be tolerated and may be cause for immediate dismissal from camp. 21. CAs will be required to be in their bunks no later than 9. CAs should never put themselves in a position where 10:00 pm. they are alone with a child. 22. CA's and parents must understand that CAs are considered campers and at no time are to call themselves or solely 10. No child, regardless of age, should ever enter a bathroom alone in camp or on a field trip. play the role of a YMCA Staff member. 11. Using, possessing, or being under the influence of any tobacco products (including vapes), alcohol, marijuana or illegal drugs is prohibited.
